Friday Morning Keynote Laura Brackin, PhD

Employment and Person Centered Planning (keynote)

1. The CMS HCBS Rule isn't really about walls, buildings and geographic locations. It is about a person's EXPERIENCES: Choices, Rights, and Opportunities for Integration.

2. Integration isn't some artificial ratio of people mixed together. Integration is about "close and seamless connections" to a person's community.

3. "Community" isn't just a geographic location.

4. The Person Centered Plan is the key to Choices, Rights, and Opportunities for Integration.

Moving My Agency Toward Inclusion (breakout session)

A. The ultimate goal isn't for people to LOOK included. It is for people to BE included.

B. With "opportunity" comes "risk."

C. "Managing risk" is a process used to balance choice/autonomy with safety.

D. It is impossible to eliminate all risk, but allowing some degree of risk promotes a positive quality of life.
